## Course Selection Process

It's time to request courses for the next school year. Please use this as a guide to help in making elective course choices. The selection process schedule will be as follows:

**February 23**—The counselors will meet with students to review scheduling process, graduation requirements, new courses, and elective options. The students will be given a transcript (a record of courses taken with final grades).

**February 23-February 26** —The Infinite Campus portal of 2010-2011 course requests will be open. Students will have the opportunity to select their elective choices and confirm their core courses. The student registration can be done from a home computer, school lab or from any computer to which the student has access.

**March**—Counselors will review students' course requests.

**April 29**—Students will receive a course request sheet to confirm 2010-2011 course requests.

**April 30**-Students will return signed course request sheet.

NOTE: The students are registering for the 2010-2011 school year. All students in grades nine through twelve must be enrolled in a minimum of six classes.

## Frequently Asked Questions

- **Where can I find more information about the courses?**

- **Why do I have to select courses so early?**

The course requests are used to determine teacher need and master schedule courses for the school. Students will receive a course verification sheet before school ends to confirm courses requested.

- **How will my core course be selected?**

On the registration screen the core courses of your grade level will be listed. Any changes such as course level (gifted or AP) or recovery courses will be made by your counselor.

- **How do I log-in to register?**

Log-in Infinite Campus. On the main portal page (where the notices are listed) click on the registration option from the index on the left of the screen.

Step-by-step instructions are outlined in the registration letter and on the WHS guidance website.
